Loudonville-Carioto, Anthony J. Sr. "Tony", 77, of Loudonville, N.Y. passed away peacefully at his home, surrounded by his loving family on Wednesday, April 15th. Tony fought a long and courageous battle with heart disease.

Tony was born in Albany, N.Y. and was the son of the late Augustus and Josephine Carioto. Tony was a graduate from Christian Brothers Academy and Albany Business College.
