Albany-Anthony A. Lattanzio, 87, entered Eternal Life Saturday evening, May 6, 2017 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter's Hospital surrounded by his beloved family, holding a flower bouquet to give his cherished daughter Lisa in heaven, who passed away just a few days before on May 3rd.
