Albany, NY-Raczkowski, Elizabeth A. (Kowalski) (Betty), age 84, died peacefully at the Teresian House on May 1, 2023. Born in Albany, she was the daughter of the late Michalina and Jozef Kowalski who both immigrated to the area from Poland.

Betty was also predeceased by her loving husband Stanley Raczkowski. She resided in the Capital Region her entire life and was particularly proud of her Polish heritage.
