Albany-Frank S. Cirrincione, 86, died Tuesday, February 18, 2014 at the Stratton VA Medical Center. Born in Troy, he was the son of the late Antonio and Maria Teti Cirrincione.

He was a World War II, Korean War and Vietnam War Marine Corps Veteran. He retired from the Marines as a Gunnery Sergeant. Mr. Cirrincione owned and operated Scientific Inquiry Service for over 15 years. He authored the book *Criteria in the Fallibility of the Administration of Justice*. He was a member of AARP, Disabled American Veterans and United States Marine Corps Retirees.
