Albany- Fred Forlani, in his 100th year, passed away Saturday, August 3, 2013 surrounded by his family. Born in Blandford, MA he was the son of the late Ercole and Venusta Leonardi Forlani. Fred lived most of his life in Albany and was the co owner of Forlani's Garage on Northern Blvd. for over 40 years. He was predeceased by his wife Margaret Hoetzel Forlani in 2000.

Fred graduated from Machine Shop Industrial School and then honorably served his country by enlisting in the Army and served in Europe during World War II, and was a military policeman under General Patton.
