



Gaetano C. Alonge Jr.

North Greenbush-Gaetano C. Alonge, Jr. passed away on August 12, 2017, surrounded by his loving family after battling a short illness.

Having held sales and managerial positions with different insurance firms, Gaetano co-founded Amsure in 1975 and became the firm's President and principal shareholder in 1991. Over the next 15 years, with the support of Amsure's dedicated employees and loyal clients, he grew the company into one of the most respected insurance agencies in Upstate New York. In addition to serving on numerous insurance company advisory boards and being active in several construction industry associations, he served a term as President of the Albany

County Independent Insurance Agents Association. He was always known as a fair, hard working, honest professional of high integrity and extreme loyalty.
