Malta- John Joseph Dugan, Jr. "Jack" passed away on Sunday, October 9, 2016 at the Saratoga Center for Rehabilitation and Skilled Nursing Care with his loving wife at his side. Born in Albany on August 10, 1927, he was the son of the late John J. Dugan, Sr. and Celia Campbell Dugan.

Upon Jack's graduation from St. Joseph's High School in Albany he enlisted in the Navy, where he proudly served his country during WWII in the Philippines and during the Korean War.

Jack worked for the NY Telephone Company and worked at several radio stations as a disc jockey under the Your ole handle DJ-JD. He retired from the US Postal Service after a long career as a letter carrier. He was a 55 year member of NALC Local 29. He was Past President of the Albany Musician Union Local 14, and PDDGER Albany Lodge 49 BPO Elks. He was also a member of the North Albany Legion Post 1610, the North Albany Limericks, and the Sheehey Palmer VFW 6776.
