Latham-Joseph F. Rizzo passed away suddenly at home in Latham with his wife Norma at his side on July 6th, 2021. Born on October 21, 1932 in Albany, NY he was the son of the late Felix and Emma Tozzi Rizzo.

Joseph served in the United States Navy from 1952 to 1954 and was awarded the National Defense Service Medal. He graduated from Christian Brothers Academy at the age of 16. He attended Siena College for two years. Joseph worked at the former Schaefer Brewery, then the New York State Department of Tax and Finance for 18.5 years. He had a love of sports and was an avid fan of the NY Yankees and the NY Giants. He enjoyed Manhattans and playing Bocci.
