



Rev. Lloyd A. Rebeyro

December 4, 1942 - January 21, 2021

Albany-Reverend Lloyd A. Rebeyro 78, entered Eternal Life Thursday, January 21 Anno Domini 2021 from complications of Covid-19.

Father Lloyd was born in Zanzibar, Africa on December 4 Anno Domini 1942 and was the son of the late Philip and Mollie Rebeyro. He was educated at the St. Joseph's School in Zanzibar and in 1963 he entered the Holy Ghost Missionary College, Kimmage Manor, Dublin, Ireland. Father Lloyd was ordained thereafter into the Congregation of the Holy Spirit (Spiritans, Holy Ghost Fathers) in Dublin.

Father taught for many years at Rockwell College in Cashel, Tipperary Ireland and some years after he emigrated to the United States and ministered in the Diocese of Boston.

Subsequently he relocated to the Albany, NY area and was incarnated into the Diocese of Albany ministering as a Diocesan priest for many years at St. Mary's Church in Albany, NY.

Father Lloyd had a love of animals having bred dogs and also raising chickens and ducks for many years. He was a great traveler and enjoyed visiting with friends from all over the world. Father also served on board many cruise ships as a chaplain meeting many lifelong friends.

Father is survived by his sisters Iris D'Silva of Toronto, Linda Cotta of Montreal, brothers Alban Reibero of Paris, France and Gabriel Rebeyro of Milton, Keynes, England. He was predeceased by his brother Kenneth Rebeyro and sister Carol Rebeyro. Father is also survived by many nieces and nephews.
