Voorheesville- Marilyn (Skicki) Lloyd, 91, of Voorheesville, wife of the late William H. Lloyd, passed away on Sunday, July 4, 2021 at St Peter's Hospital after a brief illness.

Born in Troy, New York on May 18, 1930, Marilyn was the daughter of the late William and Marion (Weiland) Skicki. Marilyn graduated from Albany High School where, in the 8th grade, she met the love of her life, William H. Lloyd. The two were married on February 2, 1953. Shortly after their marriage, Bill left for Korea and Marilyn lived at 313 First Street, in Albany with her parents. Upon his return, they started their family.

Spending time with loved ones was always important to Marilyn. In 1967 she and Bill built a camp in Willsboro, NY. Marilyn loved her summers at the lake, hosting gatherings for family and friends. The Lloyd Camp remains the summer home for the Lloyd Family.

Later in life, Marilyn took a position as a cook at Voorheesville Elementary School. This gave her much joy as she was able to see several of her grandchildren and their friends each day. She came to be known as Nana to many of the children at the school. Bill often joked that she spent her paycheck on ice cream for them all.

Marilyn leaves behind her four children; William (Cam) Lloyd, Robin Belzile, Lynn McNaughton (James) and Sharon Conroy. She is also survived by her eight grandchildren; Lauryn (Christine) Joseph, Evan (Bridget) Mack (Dana) Ian, Rolla, Olivia and Aidan and three great-grandchildren; Porter, Maeve, and Georgia. Marilyn is predeceased by her husband William, her parents and her brother, William S. Skicki.
