Loudonville, NY-Mary Rose (Mullany) Farina, 85 passed away peacefully with her son Michael at her bedside on Tuesday, August 2, 2022 at St. Peter's Hospital. Mary Rose was born in Albany on May 18, 1937 to James and Mary (Severino) Mullany. Mary Rose attended Vincentian Institute and Albany High School and worked for the New York Telephone Company following her graduation. In 1958 she married Nicholas Farina during a blizzard. Mary Rose became a stay at home mom following the birth of her son Michael; returning to work in 1978 as a monitor in the South Colonie School District retiring in 1995.

Mary Rose enjoyed bus trips, bingo, outings to casinos and visiting with her family, friends and neighbors. Mary Rose was active in the West Albany Italian Benevolent Society (WAIBS) Women's Auxiliary most recently as Chaplin and as a long-time fierce competitor in the bocce and dart leagues. She was a member of the Christ Our Light Seniors where she served as membership secretary and was a communicant of Christ Our Light Church.
