Albany-Norma Bastiani Boice, 79, died Wednesday October 8, 2014 after a short illness. She was born in Albany, NY and resided in the Capital Region until 1992, when she moved with her husband to Tampa, FL. Due to poor health, Norma relocated back to Albany from Brooksville, FL in September, 2014.
