ALBANY- Richard James Keegan, 72, Died suddenly on Sunday, March 22, 2015 at home. The son of the late Karl Keegan and Mary Gossi Keegan, "Richie" or "Fonzie" as he was known to friends and family was an exceptional athlete graduating from St. Joseph's Academy in 1962. In his Senior year "Richie" was named to the "All-Albany" Senior Basketball Team for the Capital Region. After Graduating, he enlisted in the US Army in 1962 and served one tour of duty in Germany, he was honorably discharged in 1966.

Richie joined the Albany Police Force in 1966 and quickly rose through the ranks to become the youngest police officer to be promoted to Detective. Richie was active in the Police Athletic League and organized and led many softball organizations in the South End and Arbor Hill. He retired as a Detective in 1991 after 25 years and traveled across the country with his wife. Richie loved spending time with his family traveling many summers to Cape Cod and Atlantic City. He especially loved dancing, fishing, politics and watching the New York Mets. He was an active member of St. Joseph's Academy Alumni group.

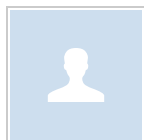
