



## Rosa V.S. Samson

ALBANY - Dr. Rosa V. S. Samson, 86, of Springwood Manor Drive, passed away Sunday at Albany Medical Center Hospital.

Dr. Samson was born in the Philippines and was a long-time resident of Loudonville.

She is survived by her sisters, Benilda S. Navarro and Teresita S. Reyes of the Philippines, a daughter, Rosanne M. Samson of Pomfret Center, CT, a son, Gregory W. T.
