Rensselaerville-William Joseph Sleasman, 83, entered into Eternal Life Monday, May 13, 2013. Born in Colonie, he was the son of the late William and Catherine Ellrott Sleasman. Bill operated Sleasman's Farm and Greenhouses on Albany Shaker Road for 45 years. He was a resident of Colonie for 65 years before moving to Rensselaerville in 1995.

Bill was an avid deer hunter and also a devoted Saratoga Thoroughbred racing enthusiast. He was a member of the West Albany Rod and Gun Club, a life member of the National Rifle Association, the Albany County Farm Bureau, the New York Thoroughbred Breeders Inc, the Whitetail Deer Association, and A.A.R.P. He was President of Bill's Hunting Camp in Rensselaerville, NY where in 2004 he harvested the largest deer ever in his over 60 years of hunting. Bill was a lifetime communicant of St. Pius X Church, Loudonville, NY.

He was the beloved brother of Betty Jones (late Ronald) of Schenectady, Shirley Pedersen and her husband Alexander of Hadley, NY and the late Lillian Daley; loving uncle of Barbara Bonificio (Albert), Michael Daley (Sharon), Theresa Duval (Richard), Robert Jones (Nancy), Kathleen Buccieri (Robert), Linda Rispoli (Joseph), Nancy Griffeth, Lori Chera (Thomas), Patricia Ziobrowski (Frederic), David Pedersen (Rita), Paul Pedersen (Jennifer), and Carol and Dennis Daley. 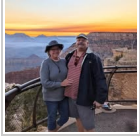

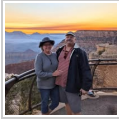
